1. Call to Order

With a quorum of the City Council Members present, Mayor Morrison called the regular session of the San Angelo City Council to order at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 15, 2015, in the San Angelo McNease Convention Center, 501 Rio Concho Drive, San Angelo, Texas 76903.

2. Prayer and Pledge

An invocation was provided by Bryan Kendrick, Pastor at Equip Church; and the pledges were led by the McKenzie Huckaby and the 2nd graders of Goliad Elementary.

The Goliad Elementary Choir led by Ms. Amaro, performed "Santa Clause is Coming to Town", "Rockin' Around the Christmas Tree" and "Feliz Navidad"

3. Proclamations/Recognitions

- a. The Miles Bulldogs and San Angelo Gators youth flag football teams were recognized for winning state championships
- b. Several City employees were recognized for successfully completing the Supervisor Safety Program

4. Public Comment

No public comments were made.

5. Consent Agenda

- b. Approval of authorization for the City Manager to execute and deliver a fourth amendment to the interlocal cooperation agreement between the Concho Valley Transit District (CVTD) and the City of San Angelo, in substantially the attached form
- c. Approval of a contract with Harrison Roofing in the amount of \$69,363.00 and authorizing City Manager to negotiate and execute all related documents for re-roofing of the Southside Recreation Center, 2750 Ben Ficklin Road

- f. Approval of declaring the north 1.5 acres of W. R. Probst 5.0 acre tract out of the James Williams Survey 121 1/2 surplus property and disposing of said surplus property under published RFB No. RE-03-16 for the highest sealed bid, being \$13,100.50 submitted by Miguel Duran and

authorizing the Mayor, City Manager or his designee to execute all documents necessary to convey the surface estate only in the surplus property by Special Warranty Deed, reserving unto the City of San Angelo mineral interests, surface and ground water rights

Approval of an agreement between the City of San Angelo and The Corporation for National and Community Service (AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps - NCCC) for a service project (from February 19 to April 1, 2016) and authorizing the Mayor or the City Manager to execute this agreement

Parks & Recreation Director Carl White provided background information.

Motion: Council Member Farmer made a motion, seconded by Council Member Grindstaff, to approve the agreement, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays

- e. Approval of an agreement between the City of San Angelo and the San Angelo Symphony Society for In-Kind Support for the July 3rd Pops Concert, and authorizing the Mayor and/or the City Manager to execute said agreement

Parks & Recreation Director Carl White provided background information.

Motion: Council Member Farmer made a motion, seconded by Council Member Silvas, to approve the agreement, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays

6. Regular Agenda

- a. Approval of awarding VM-07-15 Fleet Data Monitoring Hardware and Service to AssetWorks LLC under the purchasing co-op U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) Contract #GS-35F-4731G, in an amount of \$66,730 in initial hardware costs and \$131,602 annual subscription costs thereafter, in substantially attached form, and authorizing City Manager to execute the said contract

A Presentation was made by Fleet Services Superintendent Ryan Kramer. *A copy of the report is part of the permanent supplemental record.*

Citizen Harry Thomas expressed support for this program.

Motion: Council Member Grindstaff made a motion, seconded by Council Member Farmer, to approve awarding VM-07-15, as presented. The motion carried four (4) ayes to three (3) nays with Council Member Gonzales, Council Member Silvas and Mayor Morrison casting the dissenting votes.

Recess: At 10:08 a.m. Mayor Morrison called for a recess.

Reconvene: At 10:27 a.m. the meeting was reconvened.

- b. First public hearing and approval of an ordinance amending the San Angelo Code of Ordinances by amending Section 6.03.031 "Adoption And Amendments", deleting Section 6.03.063 " and adding Article 6.05 "Open Burning" as well as amending Chapter 10 "Traffic Control" Section 10.04.008 "Fire Lanes"

A Presentation was made by Fire Marshal Ross Coleman. *A copy of the report is part of the permanent supplemental record.*

Motion: Council Member Farmer made a motion, seconded by Council Member Silvas, to approve the ordinance, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays

- c. First public hearing and approval of an ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of San Angelo, Texas by deleting and replacing Chapter 4 Article 4.05 "Dangerous Buildings" in its entirety; providing for severability; providing for a penalty; and providing for an effective date

A Presentation was made by Fire Marshal Ross Coleman and Dangerous Buildings/Fire Inspector Joanna Jackson. *A copy of the report is part of the permanent supplemental record.*

Motion: Council Member Self made a motion, seconded by Council Member Farmer, to approve the ordinance, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays

- d. Postponement of First public hearing and consideration of introducing an ordinance amending Chapter 4, Article 4.04, Section 4.04.061 to adopt the 2015 edition of the International Building Code

This item was postponed to a future meeting.

- e. Consider approval and public hearing of the 2014 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER)

A Presentation was made by Neighborhood Services Director Bob Salas. *A copy of the report is part of the permanent supplemental record.*

Motion: Council Member Grindstaff made a motion, seconded by Council Member Farmer, to approve the CAPER, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays

- f. Review, discussion, and possible action on the ordinance and bylaws governing the Animal Shelter Advisory Committee (ASAC)

A Presentation was made by Neighborhood Services Assistant Director James Flores. *A copy of the report is part of the permanent supplemental record.*

Consensus of Council was to direct staff to proceed as presented, with the exception of City Manager recommending board members.

- g. Approval of adoption of an resolution of general support for a Low Income Housing Tax Credit (LIHTC) project by Zimmerman Properties, LLC to construct affordable housing apartments in San Angelo on 29th and MLK Ave

A Presentation was made by Neighborhood Services Director Bob Salas and Zimmerman Properties Vice President Paul Holden. *A copy of the report is part of the permanent supplemental record.*

Citizens Garland Freeze and Dudra Butler spoke in support of this resolution.

Motion: Council Member Grindstaff made a motion, seconded by Council Member Farmer, to adopt the resolution, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays

- h. First public hearing and consideration of an ordinance amending chapter 10 "Traffic Control", Article 10.03 "Operation of Motor Vehicles" of the Code of Ordinance of the City of San Angelo, Texas by adding Division 6 " Use of wireless communication devices"; Providing for a penalty; providing for severability, and providing an effective date

A presentation was made by Assistant Police Chief Jeff Fant. *A copy of the report is part of the permanent supplemental record.*

Motion: Council Member Fleming made a motion, seconded by Council Member Farmer, to approve the ordinance, as presented. The motion carried six (6) ayes to one (1) nay with Council Member Self casting the dissenting vote.

Reconvene: At 12:45 a.m. the meeting was reconvened.

- i. First Reading and Public Hearing for Case Z15-06, an Ordinance approving a request from the Petra Firma Development Group, Inc. to authorize a Rezoning from the Ranch & Estate (R&E) Zoning District to the Single-Family Residence (RS-1), Low Rise Multifamily Residence (RM-1), and General Commercial (CG) Zoning Districts, on 44.821 acres generally located north of Arden Road, west of F.M. 2288

Motion: Council Member Silvas made a motion, seconded by Council Member Fleming, to approve the ordinance, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays

- k. First Reading and Public Hearing on the adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 2 "Administration and Personnel," Article 2.07 "Boards, Committees and Commissions," Division 3 "Zoning Board of Adjustment"

Motion: Council Member Farmer made a motion, seconded by Council Member Grindstaff, to approve the ordinance, as presented. The motion carried unanimously seven (7) ayes to zero (0) nays
